### Casual boarding

\$90 per night up to 4 nights

\$450 per week for 5 to 7 nights of that week

### Day boarding

Day boarding services are provided from the end of the school day until 8:30pm. The cost is \$35 per day, which includes the use of the Boarding House for after-school activities, an evening meal and supervised homework with the boarders. To book call the Boarding House on (03) 6211 4928.

### Other costs

**Year 9 ASPIRE** A co-contribution of \$300 per term will be charged in Terms 1, 2 and 3 for compulsory Year 9 ASPIRE experiences.

**Year 10 Connect** A co-contribution of \$300 per term will be charged in Terms 1 and 3 for compulsory Year 10 Connect experiences.

**Years 7 to 12 Electronic Textbooks** An annual contribution of \$140 will be charged for access to electronic textbooks. Detailed information will be provided separately.

**Building Fund** \$50 per student each term is optional and tax deductible.

**Additional optional activities** Outdoor Education camps, private music, art or sport lessons, Year 6 Canberra trip in Term 4, selected Year 10 experience trips, see handbook.

**Rowing** A levy applies to students involved with the rowing program.

**Bus services** The School offers pick up and drop off bus services for younger students. Fees applicable depend on the regularity of service. Full details are on the School website [www.collegiate.tas.edu.au/bus-service](http://www.collegiate.tas.edu.au/bus-service)

### Computers

Junior School students are provided with an iPad by the School. Prescribed notebook computers are compulsory for all Middle School students in Years 5 to 7. Years 8 to 12 students participate in our Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program. ### Sibling concessions

- 10% concession on tuition fees for 2nd sibling attending at the same time.
- 20% concession on tuition fees for 3rd sibling attending at the same time.
- 35% concession on tuition fees for 4th sibling attending at the same time.
- 40% concession on tuition fees for 5th and any subsequent siblings attending at the same time.

Sibling concessions only apply when a family receives no other discount.

### Regular payments

Fees are to be paid by the due date on the statement each term. The School will accept regular payments from a bank or credit card account for 10 months of the year, commencing in February and concluding in November of the same year.

### Prepayments

Where annual tuition fees are paid in full on or before 28 February 2021, a discount of \$200 per year for Junior School students and \$400 per year for Middle and Senior School students will apply. ### Withdrawal requires one term's notice in writing

Accounts are sent before the beginning of each term and are payable within 30 days. One full school term's notice in writing must be provided to the Principal if a student is withdrawing from the School. If one full school term's notice in writing is not received then one term's tuition fees will be charged.

This is a strictly enforced policy that is necessary to plan classes and to offer places to others applying for enrolment.
