### Junior fees Kindergarten to Year 4

Tuition \$AUD	\$ 4,600 per term \$18,400 per year

Boarding is available from Year 6 for international students.

### Other costs

Optional activities have additional costs including outdoor education camps, private music, art and sport lessons and selected Year 10 experiences.

**Year 9 Aspire** A co-contribution of \$AUD300 per term will be charged in Terms 1, 2 and 3 for compulsory Year 9 ASPIRE experiences.

**Year 10 Connect** A co-contribution of \$AUD300 per term will be charged in Terms 1 and 3 for compulsory Year 10 Connect experiences.

Students in the rowing program pay a rowing levy.

### Overseas student health cover

The cost of overseas student health cover is determined by the duration of the student visa and must be paid in full at the time of enrolment. Current fees for the first enrolment year are approximately \$AUD516.

### Terms and conditions

Terms and conditions apply to payment of school fees and are provided in full, on application. All fees are subject to change each year as specified by the School Board. Fees quoted here are current fees only.

After the initial payment, the tuition and boarding fees are due each term plus any other expenses such as private tuition, pharmacy items, taxi charges and other costs.

Accounts are sent before the beginning of each term and are payable within 30 days.

One full school term's notice in writing must be provided to the Principal if a student is withdrawing from the School. If one full school term's notice in writing is not received then one term's tuition fees will be charged. This is a strictly enforced policy that is necessary to plan classes and to offer places to others applying for enrolment.

The boarding fee includes holiday accommodation for two weeks in April and October.

### Computers

Junior School students are provided with an iPad by the School. Notebook computers are compulsory for all Middle School students in Years 5 to 7. Collegiate has negotiated special pricing and specifications for the approved 2021 device, the HP Probook x 360 G6 EE notebook. Years 8 to 12 students participate in our Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program.
